More than 6,700 cadets will have the opportunity to participate in CAP activities in 2021 — more than 2,000 during March Break. The CAP run for your corps/squadron will be open for all cadets to participate.

WHAT WOULD MY DAY LOOK LIKE?

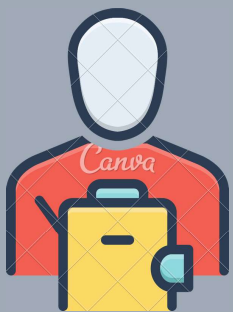
