

## CADET KIT LIST

The following items are required for participation in the Band Clinic. Cadets will be staying overnight at HMCS CATARAQUI Naval Reserve Building in Kingston On. A gear check will be performed before departure. All participants are responsible for their own gear; any lost or stolen items are the sole responsibility of the participant.

### MANDATORY

- OHIP/Health card – original only**
- 1 Instrument + accessories (Mouthpiece, reeds, drumsticks, lyre, flip folio, etc.)**
- 1 Music Folder (Music will be provided during the clinic)
- 1-2 bag to carry all the below items
- 1 Full Service Dress Uniform (tunic, shirt, tie, wedge, boots, pants, belt) *(608 has a supply of Garment bags available for transport)*
- Any prescribed medication, medical history summary with allergies (if applicable)
- 1-2 pair of dress/sports shoes (indoor/outdoor if possible)
- 2-3 pairs of socks
- 2-3 sets of underwear
- 1 set of sleepwear
- 1 sleeping bag
- 1 Air Mattress (highly recommended)
- 1 blanket (optional/air mattress substitute)
- 1 pillow
- 1 outdoor jacket
- 1 sweater/hoodie
- 1 Business casual shirt (professional, collared preferred)

- 1-2 pair pants (dress/khaki/jeans) (no track pants)
- 1-2 shirts (civilian/professional)
- 1 notepad and pen
- 1 towel
- 1 shower sandals *(unsure of availability of showers)*
- Hygiene kit (soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, shampoo)
- 1 washcloth
- 1 refillable water bottle**

### OPTIONAL

- Cash/debit for Saturday evening activities (~\$30)
- Board games, cards, etc.
- Electronic devices – Cell phones, Music players, cameras. *(To be brought at owner's expense)*

### FORBIDDEN

- Knives
- Matches, lighters, or other fire starters, pyrotechnics
- Illicit substances
- Bear, dog, or pepper spray
- Any other item deemed unsafe by an Officer
