# Welcome to Mountainview Cadet Flying Training Centre


#### 1. Introduction to Mountainview CFTC

a. Although they share the same accommodations and support, Mountainview CFTC and Trenton CTC are completely separate Cadet Training Centers.

b. Mountainview hosts the Glider Pilot Course, taking full advantage of the Mountainview Aerodrome.

#### 2. Location

a. Mountainview is located just outside CFB Trenton, in Prince Edward County.



#### 3. Pilot Course Forms and Information

a. Along with the information provided to you in the Common Joining Instructions, Air Cadets attending a Pilot Course require additional forms and information. We've attached this additional information to the Annex as Appendices.

#### 4. Mountainview Amenities

a. Mountainview uses the same amenities as Trenton CTC.

#### 5. Power Course Flying Centres

a. Air Cadets attending a Power Pilot Course will be housed in a facility located near their flying centre. Local amenities and instructions will be provided by the Course Officer.

# Amenities

#### 6. Canteen

a. Trenton has a cadet canteen, which is accessible during off-training hours for use. This facility has some arcade game, a tuck shop (for snacks, supplies, etc), movies, and on-going activities to help you unwind.

### 7. Laundry Services

a. Trenton has a laundry service, which is available to all cadets. It is expected that cadets will look after their personal hygiene at all times, which includes washing their clothes. Please ensure that your laundry detergent is compatible with HE machines.

b. Laundry bags may be provided by the training centre, so make sure you take advantage of them to avoid losing your items.

c. It is absolutely important that you write your name on your clothing to prevent loss and speed up recovery.

#### 8. Cadet Bank

a. Trenton has a Cadet Bank service available at the cadet canteen.

#### 9. Barber Services

a. A barber is available to cadets during off-training hours.

#### 10. Public Telephones

a. Telephones are available for cadets to use during off-training hours. Costs associated with their use are your responsibility. Long distance calling cards are recommended.

#### 11. Spiritual Services

a. A multi-denominational staff of chaplains and spiritual elders are available to cadets attending courses. Every effort is made to ensure that cadets meet with a leader of their denomination.

b. Cadets wishing to attend Sunday Services must inform their course staff upon arrival.

#### 12. Food

a. Meals are served three times a day in a cafeteria-style mess hall. Timings for meals are very strict, so it's important to follow your course staff.

b. Every effort is made to meet dietary restrictions, so please inform your course staff if you have any concerns or dietary needs.



c. Cadets attending exercises in the field are provided with individual rations or boxed lunches.

#### 13. Accommodations

a. Trenton accommodations are hard structures (buildings), divided by course and genders.

b. Course cadets can expect to be housed with several of their peers for the duration of their course. All accommodations are strictly enforced gender-specific, so no members of the opposing gender may access the other. Accommodations may be made for cadets identifying as transgender, depending on the location and the comfort level of all members.

c. Some courses require cadets to sleep outside in tents during specialized training.

#### 14. Medical and Dental Services

a. Every morning, the onsite medical team hosts a sick parade, where ill or injured cadets may attend to receive treatment. Cadets are not penalized for accessing this service when a need exists.

b. These medical teams may also be dispatched, along with Emergency Medical Services to assist with medical emergencies requiring advanced care.

c. The nearest hospital is located in Trenton, ON.



# Visiting Trenton CTC and Mountainview CFTC

#### 15. Visitor Access

a. Access to Trenton and Mountainview are restricted to authorized personnel only.

b. Anyone wishing to visit a cadet or take them on leave must complete the Cadet Leave Authorization Form and return it to the training centre.

c. Guests attending special ceremonies or course graduations may be required to produce photo identification upon arrival at the training centre.

### 16. Graduation and Wings Parade

a. Mountainview will host a single graduation parade for Glider Pilot Course cadets. This parade is also commonly called "Wings Parade".

b. Guests are encouraged to attend these parades to observe their cadets receive their coveted Pilot Wings.

c. Cadets attending the Power Pilot Course will receive their pilot wings at their flying centre.

Due to the nature of this course, strict academic guidelines and performance must be adhered to. As a result, additional potential exists for Return to Unit action as a consequence of training deficiencies.

- a. Failure of four (4) ground school examinations;
- b. Failure of Rewritten Transport Canada examination;
- c. Four (4) unsatisfactory (failed) flight during the course; and
- d. Academic dishonesty.
